Foreign car sales in Russia up 81% in Jan-Feb

MOSCOW. Marcy 19 (Interfax) - Sales of foreign makes of cars expanded by 81% in Russia in January and February, year-on-year, reaching 167,142, the Association of European Business in Russia's car manufacturers committee said in a press release.

Association experts credited rising consumer incomes and expansion of sales efforts outside the Moscow and St. Petersburg areas for the increase, as well as the development of consumer lending.

"In choosing a foreign car, buyers have been increasingly guided by quality and technological standards, rather than price," the press release says.
